The West Virginia University's Office of the Provost has performed a review of the Center for Veteran, Military and Family Programs. The review was informed by a self-study provided by the unit, a stakeholder survey, and institutional data on budget and staffing. Accompanying this recommendation are two additional files: the unedited comments provided through the stakeholder survey and a summary of those comments.

The recommendation for the unit is:

- Continuance at the current level of activity
- o Continuance at the current level of activity with specific action
- Continuance at a reduced level of activity
- o Identification of the unit for further development
- o Development of a cooperative unit
- o Discontinuance

The key findings of the review that led to this recommendation are:

- 1) The unit received many positive comments via the stakeholder survey.
- 2) The unit has achieved recognized improvement over time.
- 3) The unit is small, productive, and serves a key aspect of WVU's mission.
- 4) The unit has helped drive an increase in military-related enrollments and is encouraged to continue these efforts.
