

# COVID-19 VACCINE UPDATE

- ✓ **West Virginia University** will receive an additional supply of **COVID-19 vaccines** from the **West Virginia Joint Interagency Task Force** in the coming weeks, and the University is working to provide doses to those employees and students who indicated they want a vaccine.
- ✓ All students and employees based in Morgantown who are aged 18 or older and previously completed a **WVU questionnaire** expressing interest in receiving a vaccine will have the opportunity to schedule an appointment at the **Student Recreation Center** via the **Vaccine Administration Management System (VAMS)**.
- ✓ Students and employees who previously expressed interest should monitor their **WVU email** for more information.
- ✓ Students and employees are encouraged to schedule their appointments promptly. All appointment times will be on a first-come, first-served basis, and time slots may fill up quickly.
